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## What is Family Transformative Mediation?

Family transformative mediation is an empowering process for people separating or divorcing. District courts throughout Minnesota and the US require parties filing for divorce to consider alternative dispute resolution processes during the course of their court case.

In this training we will cover: mediation and circle theory and practice, family law; psychological issues of adults and children in divorce; domestic abuse; financial and property issues, and mediator ethics in family cases. We includes role plays, coaching and debriefing.

We offer a comprehensive experiential training course virtually for professionals who want to learn to mediate family disputes while meeting the requirements of the Minnesota Supreme Court's Rule 114 Training Guidelines.

Upon completion of this certified course, participants will have the skills to mediate in family and divorce situations and be eligible for inclusion on the Minnesota Rule 114 Qualified Neutral Family Roster.
